

From the Rear Commodore | Dan Gingras

We are caught up on most of the work around the club with the exception of the shed repairs, which have been started by David Wajda, Mike Coffey and others. We've changed the locks on the shed so it is always locked, and added a door closer to make sure it stays closed and locked. The shed is used strictly for event food storage. Unfortunately we've had stuff "disappear" from the refrigerator so it is now kept locked. Staff members have keys for event hosts. Under no circumstances will tools be loaned from the shed unless for work on a club project.

Minor issues have cropped up and all have been resolved without issue, the most serious of which was the failure of our gas pump which was resolved within 6 hours of the failure. In addition, the gas hose on the dock real needed to be replaced due to a deteriorated cover.

We have a significant number of staff members leaving for school mid-August, so we may have to adjust the hours during the week. More on this later. I'm going to start looking for next year's crop and see if I can get them in a licensing course in November. We will also be hosting a Boatwise launch license course in August if any member is interested. It requires that you have 120 days of boating experience, 90 of those in the last 3 years among other requirements. It takes place over a weekend (2 days) and eliminates the need for an exam at the Coast Guard

GOOD PRACTICE & RULES TO FOLLOW FOR MOORING USE

- 1. **ALWAYS** fly the Club Burgee to identify yourself as a PYC member. (Available from the Ships Store)
- 2. **DO NOT,** repeat **DO NOT** allow a non-member using your vessel to fly **your burgee** to obtain a mooring!
- 3. If PYC moorings are occupied by an apparent non-member, going along-side and asking if they are members is a good practice. Some answers may be evasive! If the occupants honestly say they are not members politely ask them to vacate. Make sure, of course that there are not other PYC moorings available.
- 4. Being insistent that a non-member vacate a PYC mooring **is not** "bad form". Remember, we all pay for the permits and maintenance!
- 5. Rafting of vessels on PYC moorings is OK. Please use common sense when doing so.
- 6. Boats are not to be left unattended overnight.



SAILING MISTRAL

Update from Carl and Betsy Stevens on Atlantic Crossing: Portsmouth to Azores to Gibraltar - July 6

We left from the PYC dock as planned on June 15 to a big send off from friends. We headed south off Cape Cod and down between Nantucket Shoals and then George's Bank where we saw lots of dolphins and whales. After passing

through a warm front we headed east hopping in and out of the Gulf Stream.

We had great weather until the final approach towards the Azores when we were stuck in a low pressure system which generated near gale conditions directly on the nose. As a result our arrival date into Horta was delayed several days as we tacked into heavy

seas barely making any headway. During the worst of it we spent one night hove to, so we could all get some needed rest. We left the Azores yesterday headed to Gibraltar hoping to avoid the orca's that have been attacking sailboats. On the other hand, we kind of want to see them too!
