

It's time to put away the parkas and put on the life jackets... Spring has arrived at PYC!

Special Note: Due to the damaging effects of the January 13th storm, Coast Guard Portsmouth Harbor floats and docks have been damaged and are not suitable for operations. Their docks are therefore closed until the facilities can be repaired. The United States Coast Guard requested, and been granted permission by the Board, to rent Slip M for the season to dock their Rapid Response craft. Many thanks go toJim Jelmberg for working with the RC to make it possible to assist the Coast Guard.

Members should be vigilant and clear a path when Coast Guard officers traverse the club to get access to their vessel. As we say, "make a hole" and let them pass. Their mission is to protect all of us and we have to do our part to assist.

We are almost ready to start the 2024 season.

Maddie Flagg has been hired to be our General Manager/Steward for the 2024 season. She and Dock Master Adam Shapiro have lined up staff to support member and guest events and activities.

Thanks go out to the many members who showed up, ready to work, Saturday April 13th, followed by the essential Docks-In work party and pot luck brunch on April 20th. The clubhouse and grounds are shaping up for the coming season. There are still several weeks of work to be done by special teams. We expect the clubhouse and grounds to open officially for member use on May 1st.

Major work has been completed to repair damage from the Jan 13th storm. Members volunteered to build new entry and exit ramps connecting to the up-river walkway, which washed away during the storm. Thanks go to Toby Clarke and Bill Rushforth for building new entry and exit ramps. Steve Falzone and Jim Haslam completed repairs to the concrete near the supply closet, and Steve also painted the concrete between the porch and pier. Also, thanks go to Terri Lareau who volunteered to paint the new ramps, railings, porch floor and help with stenciling a compass rose on the concrete between the porch and the pier ramp. RC Whit Weller repaired the porch sunroom window vinyl and latches that were severely damaged by the storm of January 13th. Members replaced the screens on the outside of each porch section. Comm. Gingras has rebuilt a special cover for the fuel system sump which also washed away during the storm. PC Andy Courteau and Tim Maglaras will be working to finish the docks electrical wiring, fuel and plumbing hookups. We have purchased a new water continuous feed water heater to replace the damaged tank heater in the cleaning supply room. All 122 "Season Opening" check sheet activities



have been or will be completed before we fully open the club.

Hello PYC members,

We are currently in Eleuthera, Bahamas getting ready to make a transit back to the US next week. We will sail from Nassau to Charleston, SC and then work our way up the East coast with the intention of getting to New London, CT in time for our son's graduation from the Coast Guard Academy on May 22. We've had a lovely winter cruising the Caribbean with our favorite stopovers being St John, USVI and Îles des Saintes, Guadeloupe. Our recent foray into the Bahamas is very new to us, and we're just starting to get used to just having a foot or two of water under our keel! It's a little unnerving at times. Now that we're headed back to the US, we're starting to think about home again and to reflect on our journey. We will both be happy to

be in US waters (with US navigational aids!), but there is some sadness that we are on our last leg of the trip. We just put our lovely boat, *Mistral*, on the market knowing that caring for a 50-foot boat is financially a stretch for us long term.
