
Ladies and Gentlemen,

It occurred to me that if the proposal I sent you a few days ago were to be adopted, it would save work for the Treasurer if we put the onus on the member to notify the Treasurer. So please delete last Friday's email, and use the wording below:

Proposal for Board of Directors to Consider

Upon attainment of age 85, current members with at least 35 years of active membership in good-standing, shall be eligible to be transferred to the category of non-voting Honorary Members, for the purpose of releasing them from having to pay annual dues, and to be able to visit the Club and participate in functions without needing a sponsor, provided that said members notify the required information to the PYC Treasurer in writing at least thirty days prior to the end of that calendar year.

The Rationale:

This proposal would not result in a loss of revenue because their honorary status would open-up membership spots for people on the waiting-list.

Also, the number of them that would be negligible and their participation would be occasional, because elders slow down.

Finally, it is a recognition of the stability that long-time members have lent to the club.
