

## Potential Board Action Concerning Marital-type Relationships

MOVED:

That the Board adopt the following requirement for information from individuals seeking:

- A.- A family membership as two individuals living at the same address in a marital-type relationship, under ARTICLE XI, Section 4 of the Constitution.
  - 1.- The date the relationship began.
  - 2.- The address where the parties live.
  - 3.- In whose name the deed or lease to the residence stands.
  - 4.- How long the individuals have lived at that address.
  
- B.- Reinstatement as a former member of a marital or marital-like relationship which has dissolved, under ARTICLE XI, Section 6, b. of the Constitution.
  - 1.- The date the relationship began.
  - 2.- The address where the former member lives.
  - 3.- The address where the former spouse or partner lives.
  - 3.- A statement that the former member was living at the address at the time the relationship was dissolved.
  - 4.- Documentation that the other person in the dissolved relationship is not also claiming membership under ARTICLE XI, Section 6, b.
  
- C.- Assumption of membership as partner in a marital-type relationship of a deceased member. under ARTICLE XI, Section 16 of the Constitution.
  - 1.- The date the relationship began.
  - 2.- The address where the parties lived.
  - 3.- In whose name the deed or lease to the residence stands.
  - 4.- How long the survivor lived at that address.
  - 5.- A statement that the survivor was living at the address in a marital-type relationship on the date the member died.

(The request for this information should be included on the various application forms.
