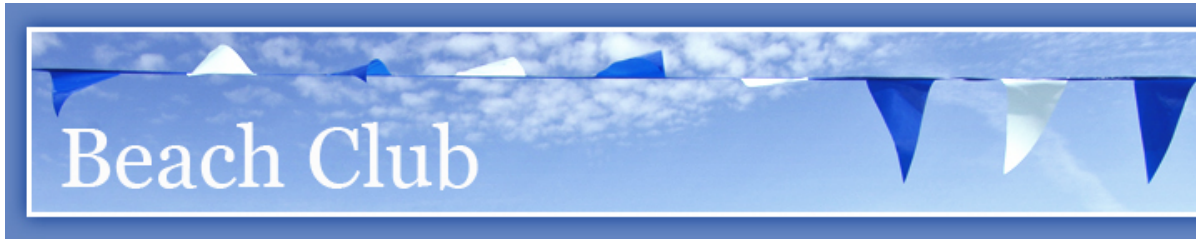




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# **Important Summer** **2020 Update**

**May 25, 2020**

**Dear Members,**

**Finally the news you have been waiting for regarding the opening of the Beach Club for the 2020 season! The deck and pool will open on Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> at 9:00AM. This coincides with the beach opening for active use. The snack bar will open on Wednesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

**The executive committee and management team have been working to open the Club as quickly and safely as possible for the entire membership community. It has recently been reported that being outside may greatly**

reduce the risk of transmission, however, experts *stress the importance of social distancing and wearing a mask when not able to do so*. Experts have also indicated that the risk of being in a pool is not the water, but rather the proximity of those around you.

Each of you will need to assess your level of risk as no one can be certain that the virus will not make it to the Club. If you have a fever, not feeling well, have a cough or have been exposed to COVID-19, we strongly ask you to stay home. We are certain that each member will continue the long-standing tradition of being respectful of the needs of other members and staff.

It should come as no surprise that there will be some changes and additional restrictions none of us have experienced before. We are hopeful that these restrictions may be eased as the summer progresses, and will make every effort to do so. However, more restrictions, such as instituting a reservation system, could be enacted or in a worst case, the most difficult decision, to close. You should expect these to be in place at least through June. These restrictions are in addition to the usual rules and are necessary to keep members safe. Most of these are provided at the bottom of this letter. Specific area restrictions/guidance will be posted throughout the Club. You will be notified of any changes throughout the season.

**We have rearranged seating and established occupancy limits to assist with social distancing as well as following local, state and federal guidelines. The Club will be professionally cleaned each day. Staff will clean tables and restrooms throughout the day. All staff will have their temperature taken daily and will wear masks when applicable.**

**We will not expect Jeff and his staff to enforce social distancing or wearing of masks for adults and children on the deck or in the pool, so we ask for your cooperation. Disregarding expectations, restrictions and/or rules not only put fellow members at risk, but also could put your membership at risk. Many hours have gone into planning the season. We hope for a smooth and sustained opening, however, we could not predict every possibility. We are collectively in uncharted waters. I appreciate your patience and look forward to seeing you on the deck.**

**Parking:**

- An attendant will aid in maximizing member parking

- Members must display their hanging parking tag when entering the lot- vehicles without a tag will be turned away. If you have lost your tag, please contact the office for a replacement.
- Enter the lot on the south and exit on the north as the lot will be roped off
- Parking at St. Theresa's is uncertain, attendant will direct you there if available

**Deck:**

- Hours of operation will be 8:00am to 8:00pm on weekdays (beginning June 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- Hours of operation will be 9:00am to 9:00pm on weekends
- All members coming on the deck will be signed in by a staff member when entering the Club
- 120 members will be allowed on the deck at one time
- When the deck reaches capacity, an announcement will be made
- Please limit your time on the deck to 3 hours
- Tables have been spaced at least six feet apart with 4-5 chairs each
- Lounge chairs have also been spaced six feet apart
- The deck will be closed from 4:00-5:00 each day for cleaning
- The deck will reopen at 5:00-8:00 for dining weekdays and 5:00-9:00 weekends
- No North Deck or Sea Deck Reservations will be allowed

**Grills/Kitchen:**

- Members will need to bring their own grilling tools and utensils
- Each grill will be limited to two members to ensure social distancing while grilling
- Ice will be provided on request-bring your own container
- The Kitchen will be closed to all members
- No Lobster Party Reservations will be accepted in June

**Clubhouse/Bathrooms/Lockers:**

- The Clubhouse and Office will be closed to all members

- The inside handicap bathroom will be available on request
- Due to space restrictions it is recommended that members wear a mask when using the outside bathrooms
- One inside shower (one person/family only) will be available
- Shampoo and body wash will not be supplied this season
- Locker access will be available

#### **Pool/Swim Team/Water Aerobics:**

- *Pool restrictions and capacity will be determined and posted by the Pool Manager*
- Early Morning Swim will begin on June 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8:00-9:00 and June 15<sup>th</sup> 6:30-7:30
- Pool will be open from 9:00am-3:30pm weekdays
- Lap swimming will be permitted from 5:00-7:00pm each week day
- There will be zero tolerance for horseplay or any other similar contact in the pool or on deck. You will be asked to leave if this occurs.
- Swim Team and Water Aerobics will begin on June 15<sup>th</sup>-details will be sent

#### **Snack Bar:**

- Will open on Wednesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 11:00am-4:00pm daily
- Practice social distancing when waiting to order-deck will be marked
- A coffee/water/ice station will be set up and staffed-staff will not refill personal containers
- Individual condiment packets will be provided

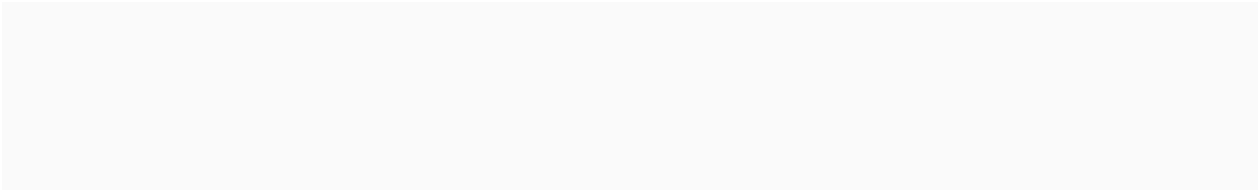
#### **Guests:**
