Opening July 1, 2020

The Great Island Common is comprised of 32 acres of seaside greenspace and beach. The Common will be open to the general public starting July 1, 2020 from 9am to 9pm. The Common is owned and operated by the Town of New Castle. The Common is not a state of New Hampshire Park.

We ask all visitors to use caution and follow social distancing recommendations/guidelines

The following changes are in effect until further notice:

- Admission fee change. We are moving to a per vehicle fee – Please see [GIC Information and Fees](#)
- Maximum vehicle limit of 160 vehicles in the park at any given time
- We are not accepting Pavilion/Gazebo reservations. **These will be available to the public on a first come first serve basis.** Please note that the pavilions, gazebos, grills and picnic tables are not sanitized to fight infections. Visitors are advised to use this equipment at their own risk.
- The bath house will remain closed
- Portable bathrooms will be onsite for public use
- The playground will remain closed
- We are not accepting Wedding reservations
- No organized activities or large gatherings (Volleyball, Frisbee, Kickball, others)
