

Vote of The Board of Directors August ____, 2020

To further implement the PYC Constitution and By-Laws, the Board takes the following action: Children under the age of 21 must be under the supervision of their parents at all times while on Club property, except that children ages 16 -21, who hold a boating license and whose parents have executed an annual Liability Agreement or Waiver, may access their family boat with guests, as provided under the BOD vote of July 23, 2020.

Board of Directors Motion Passed July 23, 2020:

A member's child, of at least 16 years old and living at home with his/her member parents may use PYC's facilities to access a parent's boat via PYC's docks or PYC's launch provided such access is limited to only when PYC's staff is on duty. The described member's child may have guests but may not use any other of PYC's facilities other than bathrooms. The member parents of a child who desire the access noted above must execute an appropriate Liability Agreement concerning said access. If any rules are violated, the family membership is subject to termination.

The Constitution And By-Laws, Including The Following Provisions, Apply To The Use Of PYC Facilities By Children Of Members:

CONSTITUTION - ARTICLE XI. Section 4.

Active membership includes individuals or families. Family is defined as two individuals living at the same address in a marriage or marital-type relationship.

BY-LAWS - ARTICLE III. Discipline. Sections 1-6.

BY-LAWS - ARTICLE VIII - Courtesy and Responsibility

A member shall be responsible for the conduct and actions of all family members and guests they may introduce to the Club.
