

AMEND ARTICLE XI. Membership, Section 12 D.

TO PERMIT LIFE MEMBERS TO HOLD FLAG POSITIONS.

AND TO PERMIT THE SURVIVOR OF A DECEASED MEMBER IN A MARRIAGE OR
MARITAL-TYPE RELATIONSHIP TO HOLD THE LIFE MEMBERSHIP.

(This last sentence is amended to be consistent with Article XI Section 16.)

By Deleting the Crossed Out Words and Inserting the Words in Red.

D. Voting on Life Members at the annual meeting shall be by written ballot.

Definition of a Life Member: A person elected to Life Membership shall enjoy all of the privileges of the Club. A Life Member may serve on the Board of Directors provided that no more than one Life Member shall serve on the Board of Directors at any one time. ~~A Life Member shall not hold a Flag position.~~ A life Member **may hold a Flag position** but shall not vote on any issues relating to or requiring a dues increase or a commitment to borrow funds. A Life Member will have been a dues paying member and shall not be required to pay dues. The spouse of a deceased Life Member, **or the survivor of a deceased Life Member, in a marriage or marital-type relationship**, shall hold the membership.

SO THE ARTICLE AS AMENDED READS AS FOLLOWS:

D. Voting on Life Members at the annual meeting shall be by written ballot.

Definition of a Life Member: A person elected to Life Membership shall enjoy all of the privileges of the Club. A Life Member may serve on the Board of Directors provided that no more than one Life Member shall serve on the Board of Directors at any one time.
