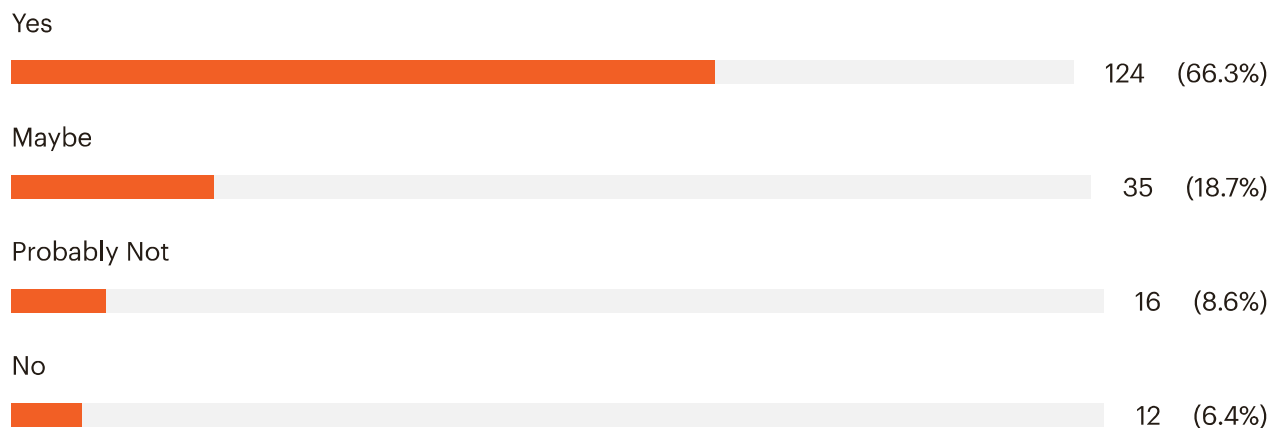


PYC Pre-Season Survey March 30, 2021

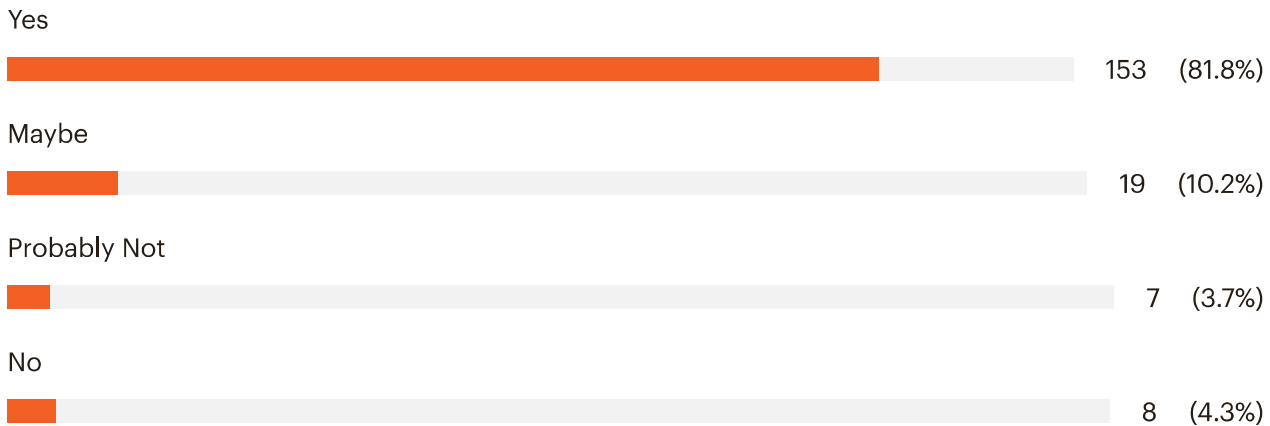
Question 1 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

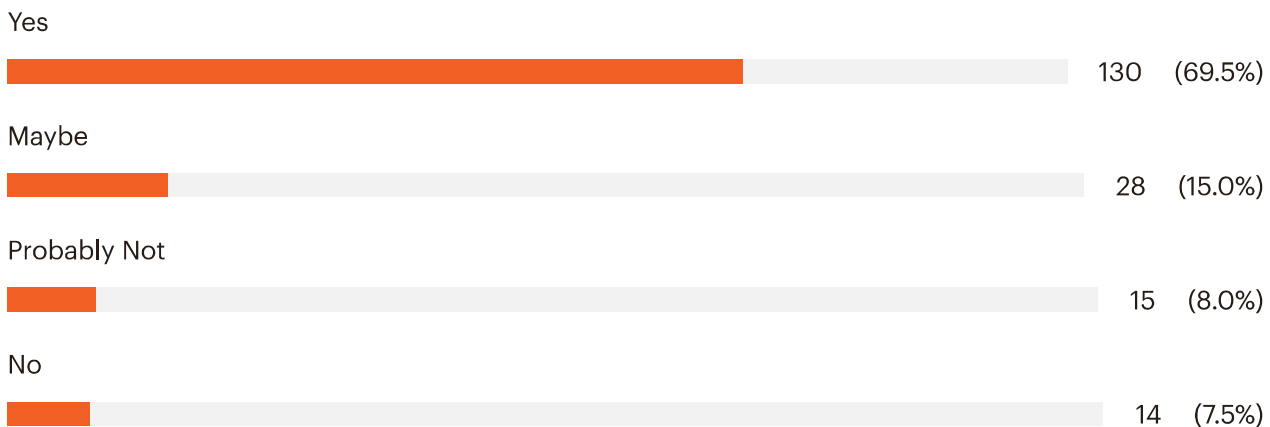
Question 2 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

“(2) GRILLS: Do you feel comfortable sharing the outdoor grills with other members, provided everyone cleans up after use?”



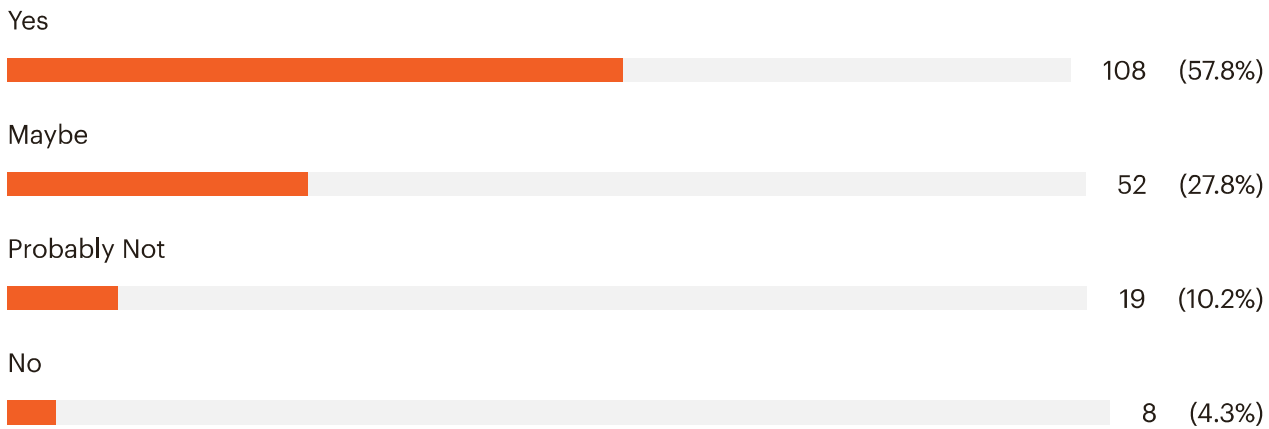
Question 3 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

“(4) SOCIAL FUNCTIONS: Would you like to attend Social Functions at the club this season?”



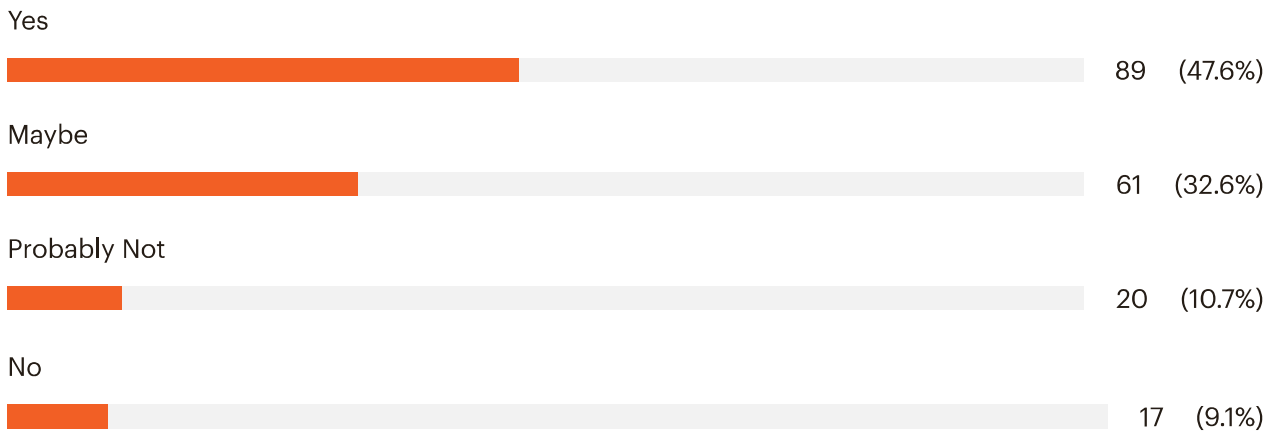
Question 5 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

“(5) SOCIAL FUNCTIONS: Do you feel comfortable attending a function where members are seated at tables next to each other?”



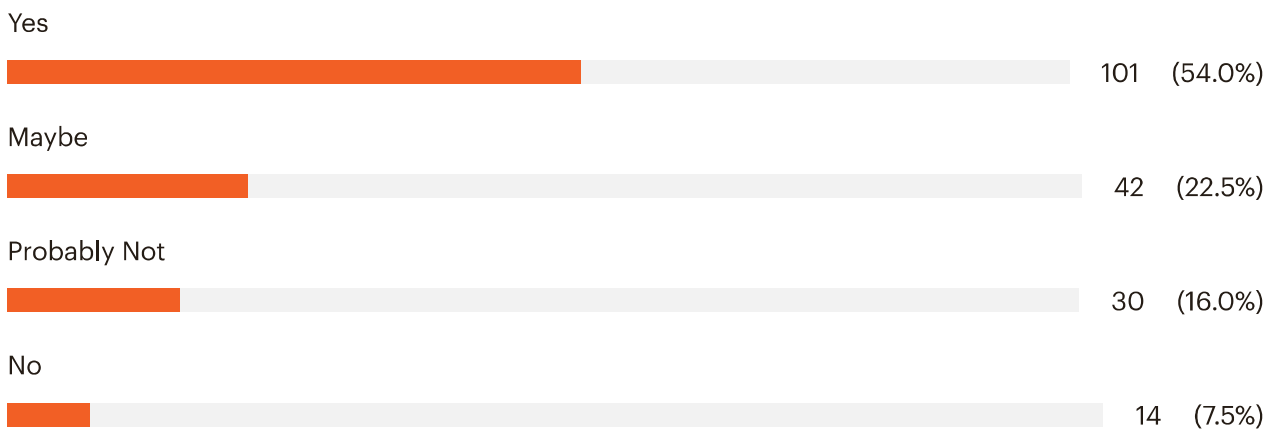
Question 6 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

“(7) ORDER AHEAD LUNCH MENU: Would you like the club to offer a 'order ahead' lunch program on weekends this season?”



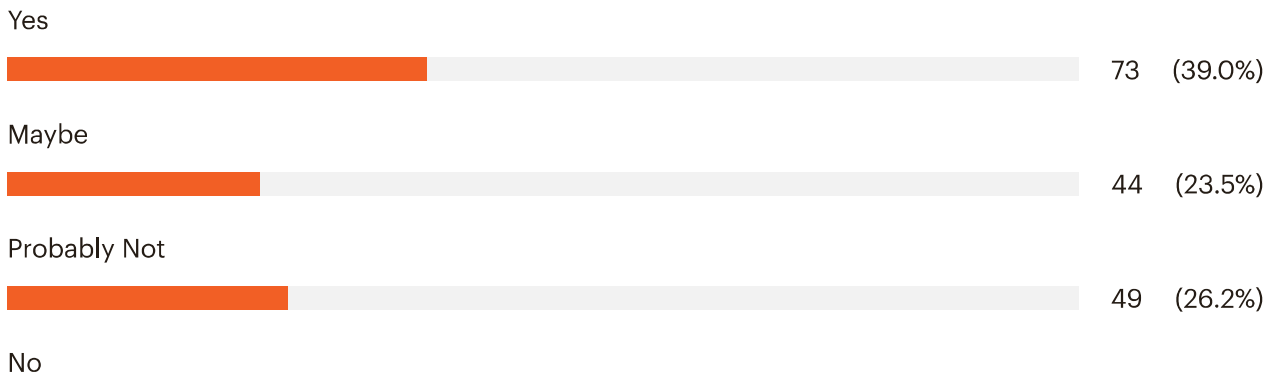
Question 8 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

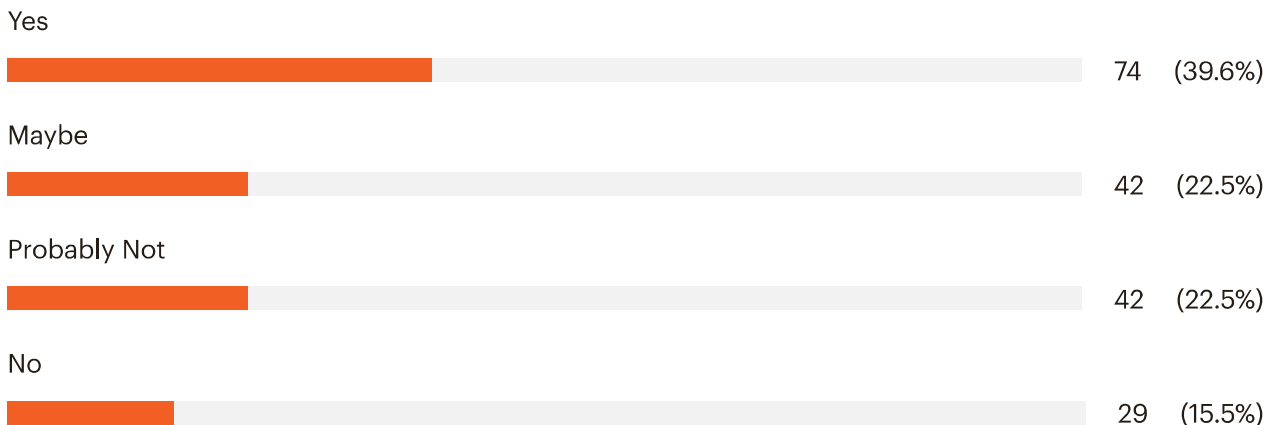
Question 10 has 187 answers (Radio Buttons)

PYCMarch 30, 2021 Pre Season Survey Responses	
1	I think that we need another year before we can safely socialize. Maybe one or two outdoor functions with masks on?
2	All sound like great ideas! Thank you.
3	I would love to see the club open. I would suspect that nearly 90% or more of our members and employees will have been vaccinated. Those that are immune compromised can chose not to attend events or mask up.
4	Has the parking issue been rectified with the town? We did not go last year but read the emails talking about no parking.
5	Looking forward to being able to use the club this season.
6	Looking forward to being back the club this summer. My concern is who will be enforcing wearing masks? I know that was a concern last year.
7	Open up!
8	Once I am fully vaccinated (which will be May 5th), I would definitely be more open to attending events at the club whether they are sitting or standing. As far as ordering lunches, as long as the restaurant has gluten free option (for celiac), I would probably order something once in a while.
9	I would like to use the soda gun if there are disposable sanitizing wipes available at the counter to use before operating the "gun". We would attend sit down dinner socials if tables are seated for 6; not 8. I think the number is important at each table - not necessary to eliminate a number of tables in the room for safety.
10	Will there be any launch restrictions this year?
11	We are interested in a PYC cruise this summer
12	Lunch menu - it would depend on how it would be ordered and paid for (online preferred) and time it would be available for pickup. All are great options.
13	Most seniors are quickly getting vaccinated. Also Gov in NH are offering vaccinations to all let's follow guidelines and open club
14	Best to be safe
15	Thoughts will change depending on conditions during the summer.
16	My concerns are same as they always have been, members cleaning up after themselves. With current conditions assuring that things are sanitized and masks rules are followed will go a long way toward making people comfortable with coming to anything at the club. Social distancing at a cocktail party may be difficult to mandate.
17	My concern is keeping the people who have to be at the club safe. People like the staff, members who prepare meals for the events, event hosts, and the flag officers. If we follow guidelines, everyone benefits.

40	I am comfortable following the CDC and DHHS guidelines on social gatherings. It currently is ok to have people unmasked if they are all vaccinated. Those who choose not to be vaccinated must follow CDC guidelines and maintain a 6 foot distance and mask. Please think about a plan involving this and be open to changing guidelines, especially if there is a 4th wave. Thank you.

42	Hi -- Thanks for all you do. It's not likely I could attend many functions, but if I'm able I am positively not worried about Covid-19, so I answered everything in the positive. Life is a risk. Trust your immune system. Everybody else is out to make money off you.

43	<p>Due to the fact that we have now paid two years of dues with no functions thus far, we feel that both the cost of food at lunch and especially at functions should be more reasonably priced. Paying as much as \$60 or \$65 per person for an event that doesn't even include a sit down dinner and dancing is too much. We would, however like to see the return of the traditional formal (black tie optional) opening or at least this year closing dinner dance(s). For an event like that with all the decorations and atmosphere it's acceptable to be in that price range.</p> <p>Perhaps some mild form of social distancing when seating people at club events could be attempted, however we realize the club doesn't have a huge area to make this easy to do. Additionally we would like to be able to have an online sign up with the ability to see the guest list for all events. This is something that could be provided by the steward perhaps with this being made available to members as it was in the past.</p>
44	Can we have someone at the Club making lunch in the kitchen as before?
45	Our decision to attend social functions will depend upon whether the number of attendees is limited; everyone must have both vaccinations; social distancing is maintained; and servers are masked. We would not attend buffets or pot luck meals.
46	At present Covid cases are going up but hopefully by July the numbers will be down. Then I would feel comfortable attending functions at the Club but with reduced numbers and be able to be outside not seated close to one another inside. You do not know if all members will get vaccinated. Also from past years experience, I do not believe all members will follow rules and use hand sanitizer nor will they clean up the kitchen and sanitize. Just as this past year some balked at wearing a mask.
47	Please leave tools to clean the grills possibly on chains. Last year the condition of the grills could have resulted in a fire. If tools are attached to the grills possible someone will use them. I would volunteer to clean them weekly
48	We have had the Covid Vaccine, both doses, and believe many, if not most of the members have had the vaccine or will have it shortly. For the safety of all PYC members we would like PYC to require members to have had the vaccine before being able to participate in indoor activities at the club. Our answer of yes to being comfortable participating in cocktail parties and dinners is dependent on PYC requiring members to have had the vaccine.
49	If anyone is keeping a tally, I would like to let you know that XXXXXXXXX and myself have been completely vaccinated for Covid-19. Thanks for all you do.
50	How about outdoor events? Or vaccinated only indoor events?
51	We would be more enthusiastic about the lobster rolls on a week day and only if everyone wears a mask and kept there distance, like last summer. We are not out of the Corona woods yet..
52	Why don't we get much better grills that will bigger and last? Example: Rye Beach Club grills.
53	I think some functions can be held inside and well as out side on our deck, especially cocktail parties provided weather permitting.
54	<p>Some members in the past have not been great at cleaning up after themselves, some have never followed house and dock rules, & some don't think any of the above applies to them and their guests.</p> <p>How can I be confident that anything will change? I would like to trust my fellow members but any participation should not come at the expense of anyone's health.</p>

55	Any planned safety measures or restrictions: masks, social distancing, limited capacity and/or guest restrictions, vaccination recommendations?
56	Re soda gun, it's hard to know if others did sanitize hands. Re table seating, depends on how many, how close and were they vaccinated.
57	It is difficult to answer attendance questions without knowing what guidelines the club is going to establish to deal with Covid 19. Does everyone have to wear masks to enter & leave the building? What will the rules be in reference to establishing safe seating in the dining area? Will visiting guest be required to sign statements concerning their vaccine/quarantine status? These are issues that our club in Florida has used to set safeguard the membership.
58	Need a weekly function where members reacquaint.
59	To me, for social functions, so much depends on whether people have been vaccinated.
60	We answered based on our general preferences, but our boat is not going in the water this summer so you might not want to count us.
61	We should follow CDC guide, masks, etc. as required.
62	Kitchen use: Masks required, I might upgrade to a yes.
63	Appreciate all you do. Mild to moderate apprehension re: Covid remains
64	Require Covid vaccination to use the club and attend functions. If this is not implemented I will not be using the club.
65	Outdoor events on the deck preferred but indoor with a limit on numbers would also work for us.
66	Most of the "maybe"s are dependent on what criteria the local restaurants are following. Basically, if the club is open, I have no problem with anything.
67	Thank you for all your work on these issues!
68	Lunch options are a bit pricey. Would probably bring my own. If the weather is nice, you would easily be able to be outdoors for awhile. For sit down dinner options a number of folks, initially, would want to sit with people the know. Most friends you'd know, would have been vaccinated.
69	Sorry to have so many "maybe"s" but for me it depends on how the Covid-19 pandemic proceeds. If I knew exactly what would be happening in June or July I could give better answers (couldn't we all!) And that's the challenge. Perhaps the best answer is to pick a best guess that most members could live with and then reserve the right to change things as needed?
70	Everything depends on the Mask policy. I would expect most all members that would use the club will be fully vaccinated by June 1. As long as the mask is optional let the season Begin. Not interested if masks need to be used in the club. Thank you
