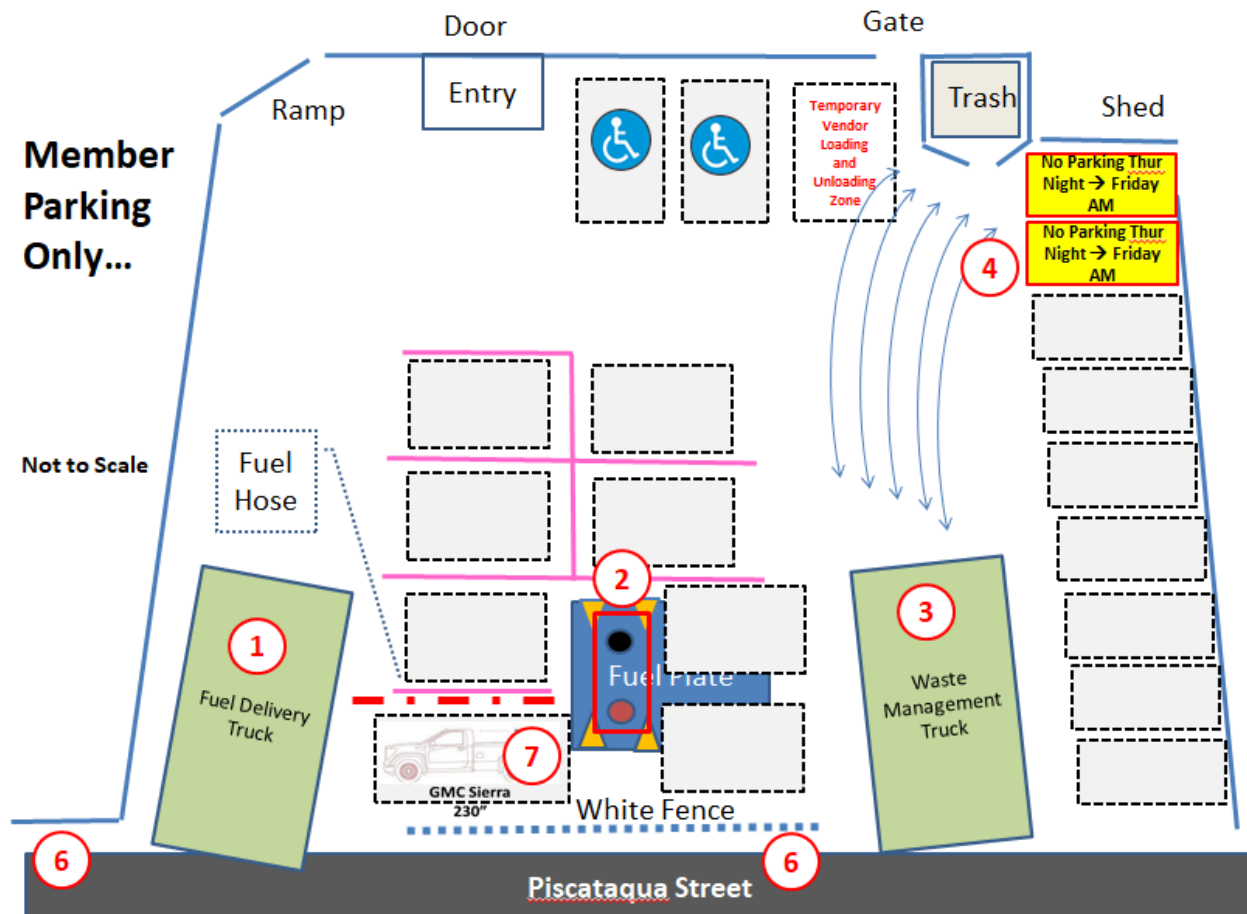

Parking Update for 2021 Season:

Parking Description... by the numbers!



A. Parking for Members Only:

- a. Only members may park in the parking lot and must display a PYC ID tag in plain sight on the dashboard or hanging

- b. Guests can not park in the parking lot and must find another location along Piscataqua street to leave there vehicles while at PYC ⁶
- c. During events, members should attempt to keep the parking lot clear of overnight parked vehicles

B. Display PYC ID tag in plain sight:

- a. Write member name on PYC ID tag to help staff manage the lot
- b. Place PYC tag or photocopy on dashboard or hang from mirror.

Tip: carry 2 photocopies of permit in glovebox of each car in case you need them

D. Vehicle size limit:

- a. Due to the increase in members arriving with longer vehicles, a limit of ~200 inches “length over all” has been established for most spaces so the lot use can be maximized
- b. Examples:

i. Most Locations



ii. Larger Vehicles

E. Time Limits for Overnight parking:

- a. **48 hours:** Use of PYC parking lot is limited to 48 hours Space
- b. **72 hour:** Longer and overnight parking along Piscataqua street is permitted for up to 72 hours. ⁶ Street parking is controlled by the New Castle Police and is covered by New Castle street parking ordinance
- c. **Longer than 72 hours or Weekly:** park at the New Castle commons with PYC permit dangling or on the dashboard. (Attention: PYC cruisers)

F. Unattended overnight vehicles: (If you are not present in the clubhouse or on your boat)

- a. If you leave your car unattended please leave a car key for the staff in case they have to move your vehicle
- b. Place name tag on key ring and leave in far right hand drawer at the bar



G. Staff Parking:

- a. Staff are not allowed to park in the member parking lot and should park along the road 6
- b. The Steward is allowed to park in the parking lot except during events and when the parking lot is in high demand by members

H. PYC fuel fill ups:

- a. Fuel truck will back into the exit and string the hose between vehicles 1
- b. Fill cap locations will remain cordoned off for parking to allow fuel hose access 2

I. Weekly trash pickup - 2 Space Parking Ban: PYC trash pickup will be every Friday

- a. Path of Trash Truck must be kept clear 3
- b. Keep Spaces Empty For Thursday night → Friday morning pickup 4


Question 1 has 75 answers (Radio Buttons)

“I will plan to attend:”





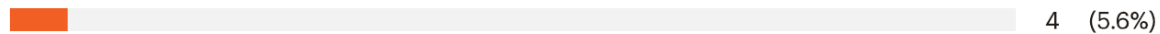
Question 2 has 71 answers (Radio Buttons)

“Would you feel comfortable coming to the July 3rd event where face masks are optional”

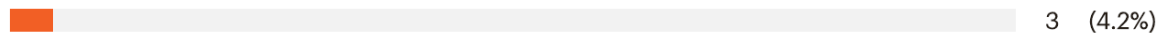

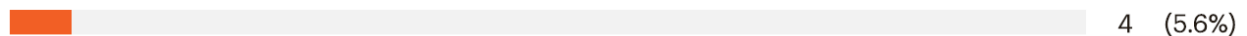

“The club needs to charge \$25 per head to cover the cost of the meal. ”

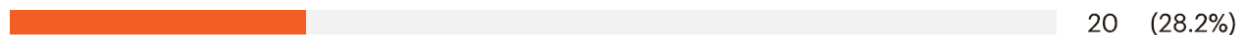

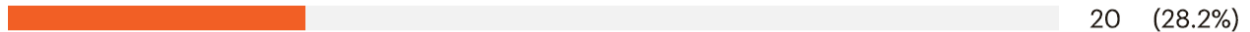

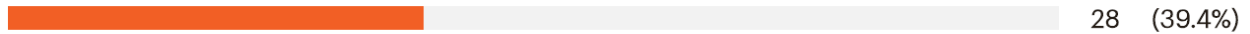
Question 4 has 71 answers (Radio Buttons)

“The price would be \$30 if the club provides a keg of beer.”

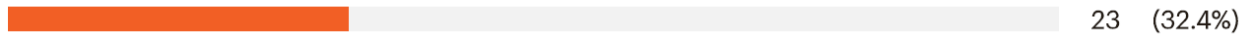
I would be happy to pay \$30 to include the beer



I would rather just pay \$25 and not have the club provide beer

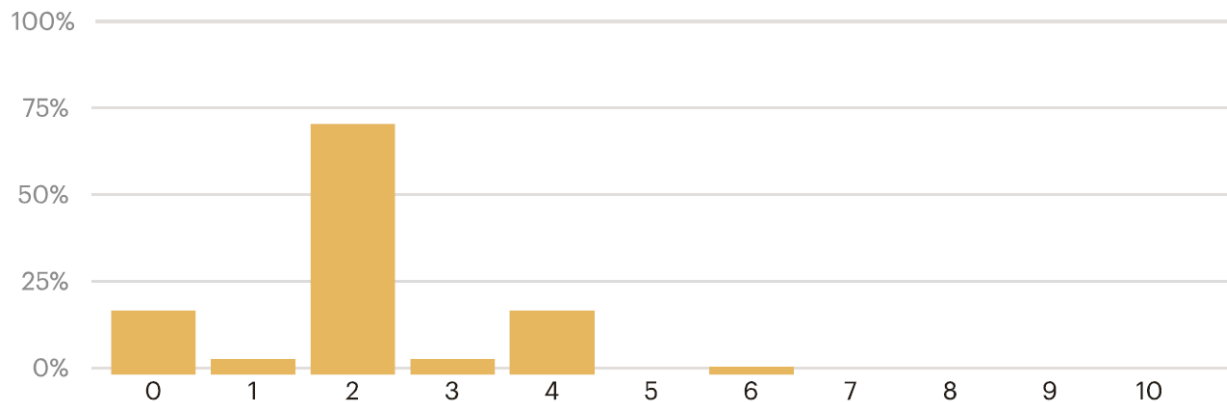
